

ABC IN DARIEN FACTS

Mission: To provide scholarships to academically talented girls of color from underserved communities allowing them to realize their academic and social potential while living in Darien and attending DHS.

ENROLLMENT: Five girls currently from New York and New Jersey.

HISTORY: Thirty-five years in Darien; 47 girls have graduated from the program.

WHERE DO THEY GO? Graduates have entered colleges such as Columbia, Amherst, George Washington, Syracuse and MIT.

STAFF: Two Resident Directors, Executive Director and Tutors.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: Twenty local residents.

HOST FAMILIES: Five families host the girls one weekend and one Sunday each month.

RESIDENCE: 103 Tokeneke Road in Darien.

THE BUDGET: \$170,000 per year, covering staff, food, utilities, house maintenance, enrichment expenses & supplies.
