How do we Select our scholars?

Scholars are selected as eighth graders and invited to attend Darien High School on a four year scholarship. All A Better Chance scholars undergo a rigorous admissions process to become a part of the program. First, teachers, administrators, guidance counselors, ABC alumni, and other volunteers nationwide identify promising students and recommend that they look into the ABC Program. These students demonstrate both academic talent and strong motivation to succeed. Each candidate completes the application requirements of A Better Chance National, including multiple questionnaires, essays and the SSAT or ISEE. ABC in Darien then selects the students who best match and might benefit from the educational, cultural, and social opportunities our local program has to offer. The top candidates are invited to come to Darien for a couple of days to interact with current ABC students, our resident staff, and the ABC in Darien Selection Committee. In addition, they also visit Darien High School and attend classes. The Selection Committee then makes the final decisions on which students are invited to participate in the ABC in Darien program.

ABC IN DARIEN FACTS

MISSION: To provide scholarships to academically talented girls of color from underserved areas allowing them to realize their academic and social potential while living in Darien and attending DHS.

ENROLLMENT: Six girls currently from New York, New Jersey and Georgia.

HISTORY: Thirty-five years in Darien; 45 girls have graduated from the program.

WHERE DO THEY GO? Graduates have entered colleges such as Columbia, Cornell, George Washington, Syracuse and MIT.

STAFF: Two Resident Directors, Executive Director & Tutors.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: Twenty-two local residents.

HOST FAMILIES: Six families host the girls one weekend and one Sunday each month.

RESIDENCE: 103 Tokeneke Road in Darien.

THE BUDGET: \$155,000 per year, covering staff, food, utilities, house maintenance, enrichment expenses & supplies.
